



# Steubenville Florida High School Youth Conference 2021 **COVID-19 Protocols**

(Updated July 1, 2021)

Goal: The Catholic Servant Ministries COVID-19 Protocols for the Steubenville Florida High School Youth Conference have been set forth to keep all who attend the Steubenville Florida High School Youth Conference 2021 as safe as possible. The following protocols not only encompass the guidelines set forth by the Center of Disease Control, but also include additional precautions outlined by the Catholic Servant Ministries.

## Definitions:

All participants: Group Leaders, Adult Chaperones, Youth, Mercy Crew, Prayer Ministers, General Volunteers, Priests, Deacons, Seminarians, Religious Brothers and Sisters

Staff: Catholic Servant Ministry Staff and Board Members, Production Crew, and representatives of Franciscan University of Steubenville

Ministry Team: Host, Speakers, Team Priest, Worship Leader and Band Members

CDC: Center of Disease Control

## **SECTION 1: Catholic Servant Ministries Protocols**

### **1. General Information and Guidelines**

- a. The Ministry Team, all participants and staff who are **fully vaccinated are not required to wear face masks** in all indoor public spaces until further notice. Those that are fully vaccinated are welcome to wear face masks if they choose to do so.
- b. The Ministry Team, all participants and staff who are **NOT fully vaccinated are expected to wear face masks** that cover the nose and mouth in all indoor public spaces until further notice.
- c. The Ministry Team, participants, and staff will be required to adhere to the current social distancing protocols set for by the CDC. (Floor decals, tape, rope and stanchion, and signs will be utilized to assist participants in social distancing protocols).
- d. The Ministry Team, participants, and staff will regularly wash their hands or utilize one of the many hand sanitation stations within the convention center.

### **2. Conference Check-In**

- a. Begins on July 16, 2021 at 1:30 p.m.
- b. Only the Group Leader may check-in the group and collect all conference materials.
- c. Group Leaders must adhere to the social distancing protocols utilizing the floor decals.

### 3. Mass

- a. For all masses being held during the conference, we will follow the guidelines set forth by Most Reverend John Noonan, Bishop of Orlando including the Friday Traveler's Mass, Saturday Daily Mass and Sunday Mass.

### 4. Reconciliation

- a. Located in smaller convention rooms to serve as individual confessional rooms.
- b. Doors will remain open at all times.
- c. Two chairs will be spaced 6 feet apart to allow for social distancing.

### 5. Meals

- a. Tables will be spaced at a minimum of four feet apart to accommodate for social distancing.

### 6. Main Sessions/Workshops

- a. Groups will have assigned sections within the main venue.
- b. Groups will be seated by registered group name. We will not combine groups/parishes for seating regardless of travel arrangements.
- c. Groups will be spaced at a minimum of 4 feet apart from other groups.

### 7. Prayer Ministry

- a. If a participant needs additional prayer, the prayer minister will remain at minimum of 6 feet from the participant in need.

### 8. Marketplace

- a. Cash, Visa, Mastercard, American Express, Discover, Debit Cards, Apple Pay, Android Pay, and Checks will be accepted.

### 9. First Aid

- a. Minimum first aid will be offered to include:
  - i. Small and large Band-Aids, feminine products, instant cold pack, adhesive tape, hydrogen peroxide, sterile bandages
- b. Catholic Servant Ministries will **not** provide or distribute any medication including but not limited to:
  - i. Aloe Vera, calamine lotion, anti-diarrhea medication, laxative, antacid, antihistamine, hydrocortisone cream, cough and cold medications, prescription medication or pain relievers, such as acetaminophen or ibuprofen
- c. Cots will **not** be offered in First Aid or by Catholic Servant Ministries

## **10. Socializing with other groups**

- a. We know that socializing with other youth and youth groups is vital to the overall "Steubenville Florida" experience; however, we ask that all participants adhere to social distancing protocols.
- b. We highly suggest that if you are allowing your youth to socialize with other youth or youth groups, you socialize outside in an open-air environment.

## **SECTION 2: Rosen Shingle Creek Protocols**

### **1. General Information and Guidelines**

- a. Based on the latest CDC guidance, Rosen Hotels & Resorts will not require fully vaccinated guests and associates to wear face coverings while on property effective Friday, May 21, 2021. Guests and associates who are not fully vaccinated are expected to wear face coverings in all indoor public spaces until further notice. Fully vaccinated guests and associates are welcome to wear face coverings if they choose to do so.
